

## **ONE ACCUSED CONVICTED IN A HURT & ASSAULT CASE**

On 29-03-2016, Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Amarpur, Gomati Tripura, has convicted 01 (One) accused person namely Prithiraj Kalai S/O Lt. Sankar Pada Kalai of Baishyamani Para PS- Ompi under Gomati District U/S- 341/325 IPC.

On 15-05-1979, Birganj PS Case No. 07(5)/79 U/S- 143/341/325 IPC, was registered on the compliant of one Sri Madan Mohan Debnath Asstt. Teacher S.B School PS BRG, under Gomati District against the accused persons namely (1) Prithiraj Kalai S/O Lt. Sankar Pada Kalai (2) Kalinga Kalai S/O Malay Kalai both of Baishyamani Para PS- Ompi under Gomati District; for hurling attack and assault upon the complainant on 11-05-1979 at about 1030 hrs at Baishyamani Para under Ompi PS.

After investigation, charge sheet was filed by SI Mukul Kumar Ghosh on 20-06-1979, against the accused persons namely (1) Prithiraj Kalai S/O Lt. Sankar Pada Kalai (2) Kalinga Kalai S/O Malay Kalai both of Baishyamani Para PS- Ompi under Gomati District; vide Birganj PS C/S No.38/1979 U/S- 143/341/325 IPC.

The trial Court on appreciation of evidence found the accused person namely Prithiraj Kalai S/O Lt. Sankar Pada Kalai of Baishyamani Para PS- Ompi under Gomati District, entitled to get any benefit under the Probation of offenders Act, the case is voluntarily causing hurt on trifle matter and at hot temper near about 37 years ago and student of that time become a responsible guardian. Accordingly, the convict, sufficient reason to invoke the provocation of probation of offenders Act keeping in mind the circumstance of the instant case, the nature of the offence and the fact that the convicted persons have no criminal antecedent and prior conviction. Therefore sentencing the convict person to any punishment or releasing him on good conduct and after due admonition released him U/S 3 of Probation of offenders Act- 1958.
